## MEDICATION ROUTES

---

**The MAT Course covers giving medication using the following routes:**

- Oral
- Inhaled
- Topical
- Medicated Patches
- Eye
- Ear
- Epinephrine via auto injector device (only when prescribed to a specific child for treatment of anaphylaxis)

If a child in your program needs medication given by injections, rectally, vaginally or by a route other than those listed above, you will need additional training. For information on the steps you need to take to give medication by routes other than those listed above, see Module 8.
