By car

Directions via New York State Thruway

- Take I 90 to Exit 59 (Dunkirk & Fredonia).
- After toll booth continue straight until you come to a "T" intersection with Central Avenue.
- Turn left onto Central Ave.
- After traffic signal look for 178 Central Avenue, Office of Admissions, on the right.
- Please park on the street in front of the Admissions Office.

Directions via I-86 (formerly Rt. 17 Southern tier Expressway) / Rt. 60 North

- I-86 to Route 60 north exit at Jamestown
- Remain on Rt. 60 north until you reach the intersection of Rts. 60 & 20 in Fredonia, about 25 miles.
- Turn left on Rt. 20 and proceed to Temple/Water Street.
- Turn right on Temple St.
- Turn right at 2nd traffic light onto Central Ave.
- After traffic signal look for 178 Central Avenue, Office of Admissions, on the left.
- Please park in the designated area on the street directly in front of the Admissions Office.

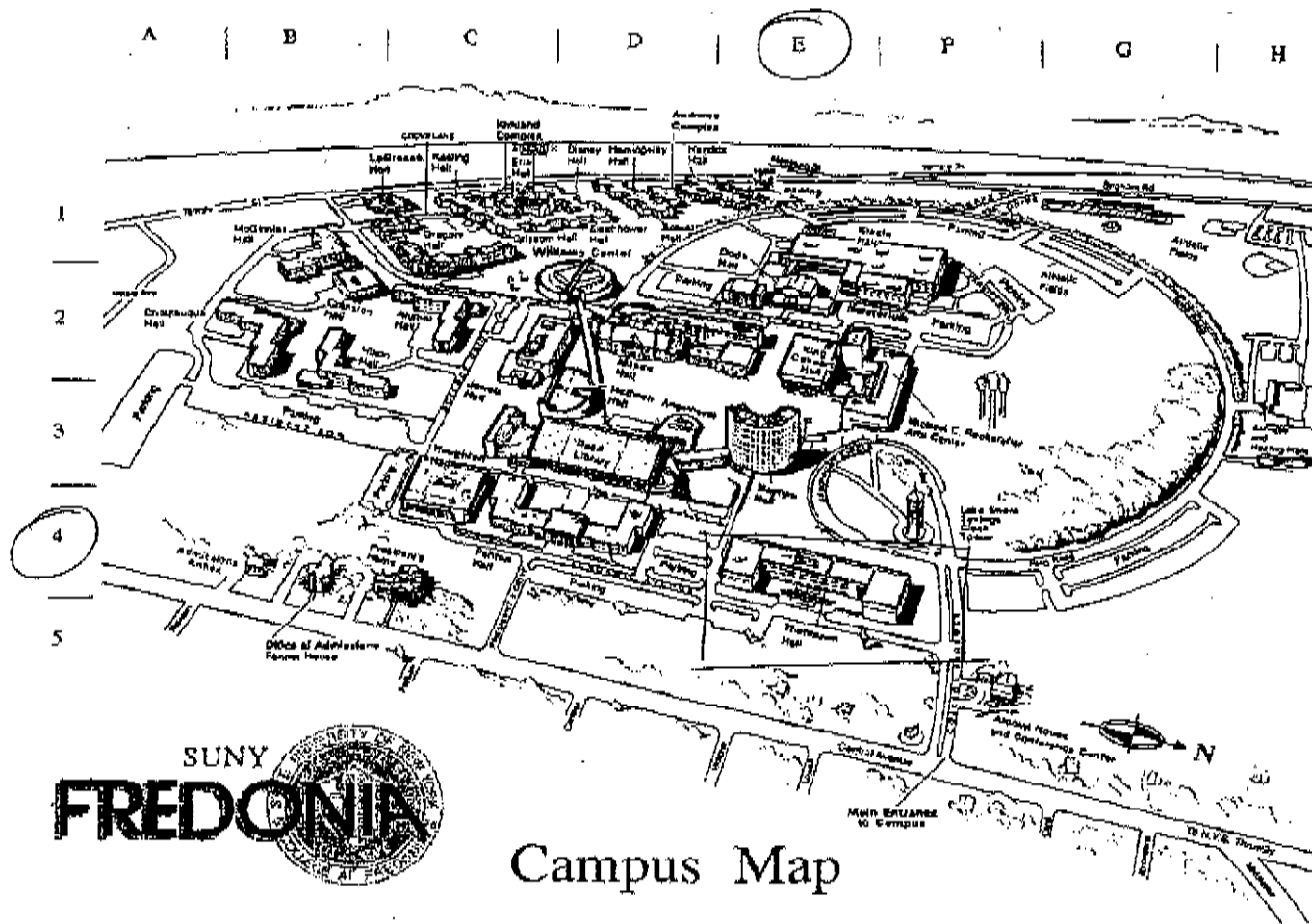
